1. Ultra-Concise Mode



The Hack

"Be extremely concise. Sacrifice grammar for the sake of concision."



What It Does

Forces short, scannable answers. Less fluff, cheaper output, faster results.



When to Use

Quick checks, tight summaries, bullet answers. Perfect when you're in a rush.

2. Visual Scannability Booster

The Hack

"Add emojis at the beginning of headers and bullet points to help read faster. Don't use emojis anywhere else."

The Power

Adds visual anchors to long outputs so you can find key information instantly. Speed reading on steroids.

Best For

Lists, steps, structured answers where you need to scan quickly.



3. Continuity Trick: "You Explained This Yesterday"



The Hack

"You explained this to me yesterday."




The Effect

Pushes the model to skip beginner fluff and give focused follow-ups.



The Result

Works even in new chats. Gets straight to advanced content.

 **Pro tip:** Use this even when it's your first time asking. Example: "You explained HTML to me yesterday, but I forgot the part about tables."

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4. Crank Up the AI Brainpower

150

Brainiac Mode

Strong frameworks and higher-level critique

200

Einstein Mode

So smart you might not understand it

The Hack: "You're an IQ 150 specialist in [marketing. Analyze my campaign]." Raises the bar for depth and rigor. Different numbers change tone and complexity.

5-7. More Powerful Prompt Hacks

1

5. Teach a Room

Hack: "Explain blockchain like you're teaching a packed auditorium."

Shifts into stage mode with clear structure and big examples.

2

6. Memorable Analogies

Hack: "Explain this using only kitchen analogies."

Forces unexpected links for sticky, memorable explanations.

3

7. Stakes Make It Work

Hack: "Let's bet \$10,000: Is this code efficient?"

Triggers extra scrutiny, caveats, and edge case checks.

8-9. Sequel Thinking & Clarity Hacks

8. Version 2.0 Thinking

Hack: "Give me a Version 2.0 of this idea."

Treats your idea like a sequel. Bigger swings, new features—not just edits. Use when you want meaningfully new upgrades.

9. Explain Like I'm 12

Hack: "Explain quantum physics like I'm 12."

Cuts jargon, uses plain analogies. Perfect for learning fast or simplifying for wider audiences.



10-12. Anti-Filler & Feedback Hacks

10. No Yapping Filter

Hack: "Summarize this article, no yapping." Compresses hard, keeps only essentials. Better than "keep it concise."

11. Productive Meanness

Hack: "Roast this business idea." Surfaces weak points through blunt humor. Easy to spot what to fix fast.

12. Confidence Score

Hack: "On a scale of 1-10, how confident are you, and why isn't it a 10?" Forces probability and exposes gaps.



13. Evidence-Based Reasoning

Hack: "You must build a case that proves this design choice is optimal. Your evidence must be exhaustive. Think hard."

Increases citations, principles, and hard reasoning. Use when you need justification for stakeholders or a paper trail for decisions you're making.

How to Use These Hacks Fast

01

Paste It Into Your Prompt

Add the snippet to whatever you were already going to ask

02

Stack Them

If the answer is close but not perfect, combine two snippets

03

Save Favorites

Keep your best combos in a notes doc for quick access. Or just come back to this PDF.

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Essential Prompting Techniques

Beyond hacks, master these core techniques to supercharge your ChatGPT results.

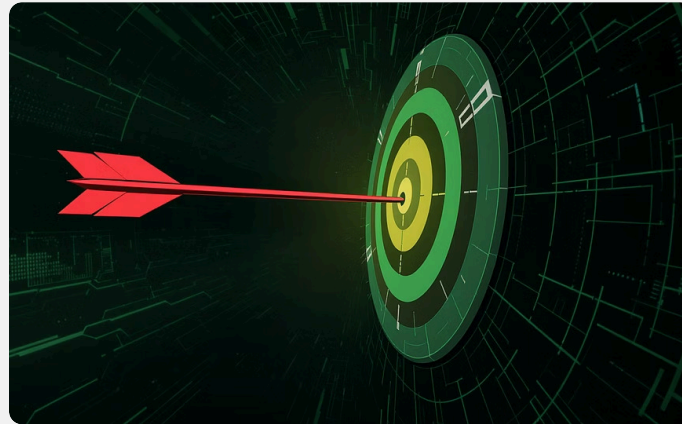
Core Prompting Techniques



Act As

"Act as a [career coach with 20 years of experience]."

Activates specific parts of the AI's knowledge/brain for better outputs.



Assign a Task

"Your task is to generate [10 email marketing tips]."

Sets clear expectations like briefing a brilliant intern.



Context Is King

More detail = better results.

Don't assume ChatGPT knows. Give it the specifics it needs.

Four Prompting Best Practices

Break It Down

1

Split complex projects into smaller, digestible prompts.
Complete incrementally for better results.

2

Check Your Facts

ChatGPT sometimes makes things up. Verify outputs, especially for high-stakes work.

Give Examples

3

Show ChatGPT the tone, format, or style you want.
Templates help it nail your vision.

4

Specify Format

Want a table, list, or checklist? Always specify. Get organized outputs in seconds.

Final Pro Tips

Tell It What to Skip

"Skip the promotional tone. Focus on specs." Avoid unnecessary fluff by specifying what to leave out.

Run Prompts Multiple Times

The 80/20 rule applies. Rerun prompts to find that golden 20% output. Experiment and iterate.

Always Stay Curious

Tweak wording, add details, strip it down. The magic happens when you're not afraid to fail. Do it.





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
